- PROGRAMS** *This committee plans annual chapter programming such as Luncheon Speaker Series, Building Tours and monthly meetings. (A)*
- ARCHITECTURE-IN-SCHOOLS** *This committee serves the children of Austin Round Rock by providing a curriculum for 3rd-5th graders for a semester. (A)*
- COMMITTEE ON THE ENVIRONMENT (COTE)** *Committee explores issues of sustainability as they impact architecture and planning. (A)*
- DESIGN AWARDS COMMITTEE** *This committee is responsible for organizing and producing the annual Design Awards Competition (EO)*
- EMERGING PROFESSIONALS** *Committee made up of both members and non-members provides an opportunity for discussion and activities pertinent to emerging professionals as they work toward registration; to encourage continued professional development after registration and to provide a support network for young professionals. (A)*
- GOVERNMENT AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS** *This committee serves the chapter by staying up to date on issues related to City, County and State government issues and the impact on the Chapter's members. (A)*
- HOMES TOUR COMMITTEE** *This Committee produces the annual Homes Tour and Premier Party for the chapter. (EO)*
- PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT** *Serves the membership by planning and organizing the professional development and continuing education opportunities (summer school) for the year. (A)*
- REGIONAL AND URBAN DESIGN COMMITTEE** *This committee is for those interested in Central Texas regional planning and urban design issues. (A)*
- SMALL FIRMS ROUNDTABLE** *This committee is made of representatives from small firms or sole practitioners who find value in sharing lessons learned about being in practice. (A)*
- TSA HONORS** *This committee is responsible for the identification, nomination and preparation of nomination packages for TSA Honors program. (EO)*
- AUSTIN HONORS** *This committee is responsible for the identification, nomination and preparation of nomination packages for Austin honors awards, which are awarded at the annual Awards Gala. (EO)*

- PUBLIC OUTREACH and SPEAKER BUREAU** *Design professionals who are willing to provide information to public groups (including schools) regarding architecture, interior design, etc. (A)*
- RESIDENTIAL** *Committee will focus on the interests and concerns of those architects and firms who practice residential architecture. (A)*
- GALLERY COMMITTEE** *This committee focuses on events, activities, and exhibits at the Center; and, policies and procedures related to the Center. (A)*
- FAIA NOMINATIONS** *This committee led by the Chapter's AIA Fellows meets to nominate those members eligible for Fellowship and continues to support them through preparation of their nomination packages. (A/EO)*
- COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE:** *This committee is responsible for overseeing the communications of AIA Austin – website, e-newsletter, print newsletter, etc. (A)*
- ARCHITECTURE FOR HEALTH COMMITTEE** *The Committee's aim is to develop knowledge and information to benefit Architects, Owners, Contractors and Consultants who are engaged or interested in the design and construction of healthcare facilities. (A)*
