Homeowners who wish to receive exposure during the Homes Tour weekend for their own products or services provided in the home will be required to participate in the Tour Sponsorship program.

The Homes Tour happens **rain or shine**. The Architect and AIA Austin staff and volunteers will work to protect owner's property. If you have questions about AIA Austin's insurance policy, please call Ingrid Spencer at 512.452.4332.

Media Policy: All homes must be made available for photography and/or interviews. All homes must be made available for publication from June 1st through October 19th. Every attempt to give advance notice will be made. The Owner's names will not be used or given to the media unless allowed by Owner. Owners may be interviewed at their discretion.

Shoe Policy: Shoes may NOT be worn in the homes in order to protect the floors. Also, bare feet are not allowed. Socks or booties over bare feet are acceptable. Special exception is given to those individuals with medical needs, in which case shoe covers can be slipped on over shoes or the person may be allowed to walk through the home in their footwear if booties are unavailable.

Meetings: The architect is responsible for attending two mandatory meetings to discuss the tour rules and schedule, Owners are more than welcome to attend. See the schedule below.
